**AWARE THAT,** The Public Finance Management Act Section133 provides that not later than ninety days after passing the Appropriation Bill, the County Assembly shall consider and approve the Finance Bill with or without amendments.

**FURTHER AWARE THAT**, The Tharaka Nithi County Finance Bill 2020 was laid on the table of the House on 10th June, 2020 following the pronouncement of Budget Highlights and revenue raising measures by the County Executive Committee Member in charge of Finance.

**COGNIZANT THAT,** the County Finance bill provides a framework for setting out the annual amount of county rates and other taxes, trade licence fees and other fees and charges for services provided by the County Government. Any increases to the trade licence fees or property rates for a particular year ought to be set out in the County Finance bill for that year and the rates and trade licence laws will remain unchanged. The same applies for increases to fees and charges for services provided. The County Government should have a clear legal basis for raising revenue as both provided for in the Constitution of Kenya, 2020 and County legislation in the case for taxes, fees and charges.

**ACKNOWLEDING THAT,** Article 118 of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010, section 87 of the County Government Act, 2012 and Standing order 152 of the Tharaka Nithi County Assembly Standing orders provides for the premise of conducting public participation.
